

# John 13:12-17 II Saved to Serve II Walt Alexander

#### MAIN POINT: All who follow the Savior must deny themselves & selflessly serve others.

## 1. The Savior's example. (v.13-15)

"For who would suffer his wife, for the sake of visiting the brethren, to go round from street to street to other men's, and indeed, all the poorer, cottages? Who will, without some suspicion of his own, dismiss her to attend the Lord's Supper which they defame? Who will suffer her to creep into prison to kiss a martyr's bonds? To offer water for the saints' feet? To snatch (somewhat for them) from her food, from her cup? To yearn (after them)? To have (them) in her mind? If a pilgrim brother arrive, what hospitality for him in an alien home?" **Tertullian** 

By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers. - **1 John 3:16** 

#### 2. The Savior's command. (v. 16)

"If he, their Lord and Master, serves them as a slave, so they should serve each other. What is not beneath his dignity can certainly no longer be considered beneath theirs." **Richard Bauckham**
